- A. Scholastic standing
- B. Financial need
- C. Contributions to the school and community
- D. Results of standardized testing

You must reapply each year. The application is available at http://wilmington-de.aauw.net or will be mailed to you upon request. The scholarship money will be sent directly to the school for tuition in two equal payments for two semesters.

To be considered, the completed application form and all supporting materials must be postmarked on or before **March 1, 2019** and include:

- 1. All pages of this application including the signature page and two essays.
- 2. Official sealed transcript(s) as specified in the application.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation as defined in the application.
- 4. A copy of the response to your "Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form" (FAFSA), which includes your EFC (expected family contribution).
- 5. A copy of the SAT or ACT scores for high school seniors & college freshmen.
- 6. A copy of the Graduate Record Exams scores, if applicable.
- 7. 2017 Federal Income Tax Forms (Form 1040, all schedules and W-2 forms) for you and your parents OR for independent students (and spouses, if applicable).

Semi-finalists will be invited for an interview during the spring. All candidates will be notified of their standing in May, 2019.
