To be considered, the completed application form and all supporting materials must be postmarked on or before **March 1, 2020** and include:

- 1. All pages of this application including the signature page and one essay.
- 2. Official sealed transcript(s) as specified in the application.
- 3. One current letter of recommendation from one of your professors at your college or university in your major.
- 4. A copy of the response to your "Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form" (FAFSA), which includes your EFC (expected family contribution). A complete copy is required. A one page email is not acceptable.
- 5. If you are entering graduate study in the 2020-2021 academic year, a copy of your Graduate Record Exams scores, if applicable.
- 6. 2019 Federal and state Income Tax Forms (1040, all schedules and W-2 and or 1099) for you and your parents OR for independent students (and spouses, if applicable).
- 7. If you call yourself an independent student, your tax return must reflect this.

Returning scholars will not be interviewed and will be notified of their standing in May, 2020.
